■ The CMC Main Bed Tower Emergency Power project consists of a 3,500 to 5,000 square foot, one-story Addition to the existing Bed Tower. It will be centrally located on CMC Main's Campus, placed so it can serve the entire Campus. The addition will house emergency power switchgears, enabling the existing campus to upgrade emergency power capability and prepare for expansion. It is designed to match the existing tower and will be integrated into a new Healing Garden. The structure will be made up of panels faced with Mt. Airy Granite to match the adjacent building. Special consideration will be taken in regard to waterproofing and fire protection of the new space to support the critical function of the new switchgears.
